


- Population: 3 697; annual population growth: approx. 0.7 %

- Distances from Uurainen: Tikkakoski Airport 20 km, Jyväskylä 35 km, Äänekoski 27 km, Saarijärvi 28 km, Oulu 311 km, Helsinki 307 km.
- Uurainen is part of the Jyväskylä sub-region:
 - Jyväskylä Regional Development Company (Jykes) Ltd. is owned by the city of Jyväskylä and the municipalities of Laukaa, Muurame, and Uurainen.
 - The city of Jyväskylä and the municipalities of Hankasalmi and Uurainen are part of the Jyväskylä Cooperation Area Healthcare Centre (JYTE).

- Education services
 - a schooling centre for classes 1-9 (ages 7-16)
 - Hirvanen and Kyynämöinen schools for classes 1-6 (ages 7-12) and Höytiä school for classes 1-4 (ages 7-10)
 - a library (part of Aalto Libraries, the library network of Central Finland)
 - Jyväskylä Region Adult Education Centre

Services

- Social services
 - day nursery *Pikkula*, private day care centre *Jokilaiva* for groups, as well as private day care, and two private day nurseries: *Helmi* and *Kädenjälki*
 - pre-schooling organised by the social services
 - services for the elderly: home care and housing services
 - Uuraspaja activity centre for people with special needs
